

Kincaid-Smith Medal - 2018 nominations



Background

The Kincaid-Smith Medal, Kidney Health Australia's highest accolade, recognises the achievements of an Australian citizen or resident for who has dedicated his/her career to research into the treatment of disease of the kidneys and urinary tract. This prestigious award was established to honour the outstanding clinical and scientific achievements of Emeritus Professor Priscilla Kincaid-Smith, AC, CBE.

In the early 1960s, Professor Priscilla Kincaid-Smith demonstrated overwhelming evidence of a link between headache powders and kidney damage, and campaigned against their use. Her research also contributed to a link between the kidneys and high blood pressure.

Who can be nominated?

The award is open to any senior researcher, scientist or health service specialist who has made an outstanding and ongoing contribution to kidney research in Australia and the successful translation of research outcomes.

Eligibility criteria

Any resident or citizen working in kidney research in Australia may be nominated for the Kincaid-Smith Medal.

Selection procedure

Nominations will be assessed and a winner chosen by Kidney Health Australia's Research Advisory Group.

Selection criteria

Nominations will be assessed on the basis of a demonstrated track record of excellence in medical, clinical, basic or population health science over an extended period. This includes but is not limited to academic and employment record, cited publications, research awards and grants, collaboration and translation of research.



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
