How the Big Red Kidney Bus works

- 1 Open to all Australians on haemodialysis in hospital, satellite unit or on home haemodialysis
- 2 Located for 6 weeks in holiday parks at popular holiday destinations
- 3 Contact Kidney Health Australia and make a booking or register interest
- 4 Arrange your holiday accommodation and travel
- 5 Kidney Health Australia owns the Bus and manages bookings online, via email or phone
- 6 Vacancies updated weekly on kidney.org.au
- 7 A state health service provides haemodialysis and liaises with holidaymakers' dialysis units
- 8 Admission criteria must be met and a *what to bring on board* checklist followed
- 9 There are 3 dialysis chairs for 12 holidaymakers each week
- 10 The Bus is staffed by a highly experienced dialysis nurse and renal technician
