Applications

Due to high demand for places on camp, numbers have been capped and we will prioritise applications for children with kidney disease before considering applications for siblings.

It is essential that completed applications are returned **no later than Friday 8th December 2017**. All applications will be considered in the order in which they are received.

Please note that a completed application does not guarantee a place on camp. We will notify you in February 2018 if your application has been accepted.

Enclosed in this pack you'll find an '**Application Form**', '**Policy Consent Form**', '**Kids Medical Application**' '**Medication Chart**' and '**Care Forms**'. These forms must be completed and returned together by 8th December 2017.

Fees

Kidney Health Australia is proud to provide our National Kidney Kids Camp to families free of charge in 2018. Once we confirm a child's attendance in February 2018, Kidney Health Australia will pre-book flights, accommodation and activities, all of which are non-refundable.

To ensure we can continue to offer Camp free of charge, we ask all families to guarantee their booking with credit card details. **Should a family withdraw a child/ren from camp after 2nd February 2018, we will charge a cancellation fee of \$400 per child to cover some of the costs of flight bookings, accommodation and activities.**

Cancellations for medical reasons should be supported by a medical certificate and an exemption from the cancellation fee will be considered on a case by case basis.

Medical Needs

Your child's doctor should complete the supporting medical application which includes necessary medical

details and medications required for camp. This form must be returned along with your application pack and include contact details of your doctor or renal unit nurse manager by 8th December 2017.
