What is the cost of using the Bus?

All dialysis sessions on the Bus are totally **free of charge** and there is no limit on the number of sessions or locations you can book.

Visitors will need to organise and pay for their own accommodation and transport to and from the Bus locations.

How does the Bus work?

There are 3 Buses with 3 dialysis chairs and medical equipment on each Bus.

You can book AM or PM sessions as needed, all for free.

The Buses are staffed by experienced renal nurses who are highly trained to provide quality medical care.
